Shoot offs will be doubles 3, 4, 5 miss and out. Concurrent and purse events will be shot off concurrently whenever possible. Shoot offs will be announced with a five-minute call. Shooters missing their shoot off will be considered a No Show, forfeiting their award or winnings.
